2010 TEAM JUDGING CONTEST

ENTRY FEES: Submit educational item to the 2010 RMHS State Convention. At check in on Saturday, please bring two (2) raffle items for the Sunday RMHS Youth Contest Raffle. All youth entering this competition MUST enter rabbits in the RMHS Convention Show and are required to work on Sunday behind the show table and/or raffle table.

Send 1 copy of the judging contest form and 1 copy of your current ARBA and RMHS membership cards to: Rosie Scanlon, 21580 E 118th Ave., Commerce City, CO 80022-9640, rockysbest@aol.com.

ENTRY MUST BE RECEIVED BY: March 6, 2010.

1. State Contest will be used to determine eligibility for the National Contest.
2. Contestant must be willing and able to attend the ARBA National Convention. Parent(s) of Contestant must provide or arrange all transportation and travel expenses to the ARBA Convention for Contestant.
3. Participants that make the State Rabbit Judging/Breed ID Team ARE REQUIRED to attend the ARBA National Convention in Minneapolis, MN, November 7–11, 2010. Any State Team member, who fails to attend the ARBA National Convention, as agreed, will be ineligible to compete at the state level for 1 year.
4. Any State Team member unable to attend the ARBA Convention must notify Rosie Scanlon (303) 654-1936 immediately.
5. Copy of current ARBA & RMHS membership card must accompany entry form. **Entries will not be accepted without copies of membership cards enclosed.** All applications received with incorrect membership expiration dates will be returned and the youth will be ineligible to compete in the 2011 Judging Contest.
6. **RMHS and ARBA memberships must be current November 7-11, 2010.**
7. Contestants must participate in their true age group.
8. State judge-off will be held during RMHS State Convention March 27 & 28, 2010, SE Weld County Fairgrounds, Keenesburg, Colorado
9. ARBA National Team Judging Contest Rules will apply. Complete set of Rules for all youth contest can be found in the ARBA yearbook. Please watch “Domestic Rabbit” or the ARBA website for specific or additional rules.

11. Winners will be announced at the RMHS Banquet/General Membership meeting.
12. Participation in the Judging Contest and Breed Identification Contest may be done without filing a Royalty application. **SEPARATE** State team judge-off and Royalty applications must be completed and sent on the appropriate form. It is the responsibility of the contestant to make sure that the correct forms are sent for each contest.
13. Please realize that due to the early date of the state judge-off contest just because you are an alternate that doesn't mean you will definitely not be judging as part of the team.
14. Team members and alternates **MUST GIVE A DEFINITE COMMITTEMENT** by July 31, 2010. Please call or email Rosie Scanlon (303) 654-1936, email address ROCKYSBEST@aol.com, and advise her of your status.

Colorado State Team Breed Identification

Each team member will be required to identify 25 animals, both rabbits and covies, listing the complete breed name as printed in the ARBA Standard of Perfection. They will also identify the showroom variety, whether a 4 class or 6 class breed, and the registration variety of each of the 25 animals. A separate animal or question will act as a tie-breaker.

Breed ID Rules

1. No abbreviations allowed. You must write Californian not “Cal”.
2. Show Room Variety/Group: List the show room classification (color), as they would be called to the judging table, not necessarily the variety.
3. List if the animal is a 4 class or 6 class breed.
4. Registration Variety. This is the variety (color) on the pedigree or registration. If the breed has only one variety or no variety listed under the breed, the show room classifications will be “Standard”.
5. All group members must go into the breed ID area together.
6. Breed Identification Score will be used in determining Judging Team members

NOTE: The ARBA “Individual Judging Contests” requires a separate application that must be requested from ARBA, completed and returned to ARBA by the Contestant. **Entry deadline for ARBA Youth Contest is typically September 1.** Participation in the Colorado Team Judging does not enter you in any other contest. ARBA requires a “Contest Participation Release Form” included with all entries. ARBA youth contest are usually held on Sunday. Call backs to break ties are posted Monday, with re-judging on Tuesday.
